10. <u>DIRECTION/DISCUSSION ITEMS</u>

Meeting Dates – The importance of getting meeting dates up on website was discussed. We do not, as of yet, have locations for all meetings. The Township is currently preparing for the transitioning to the Roma Building, which will take place the month of January, in preparation of the start of the Campus Renovation Project; we expect to list all meeting locations in the very near future, and they will be listed on website. Currently working with School District on locations and hope to have that tidied up real soon. We will have the January 15th BOC Meeting at our current location, at which time we should have a schedule with locations.

The new Board expressed a concern with transparency of information. Going forward transparency will remain at the forefront.

Q: Could we have a courtesy of the floor at the beginning and end of meeting? Township Manager Renee Bickel said that we could change the format of sign-in sheet to include the subject matter of what individuals want to bring to the attention of the Board. In this way, President Morgan can peruse the sign-in sheet at start of meeting to see what might be able to be handled earlier on in the meeting. President Morgan explained that our professional services people go first so that they can get in and out of the meetings, because we pay for their time spent at our meetings; thus the reason of having them present to BOC earlier on in a meeting ahead of others.

a. Wehrs Dam – Status No change. Waiting to hear back from PA DEP. It was decided to continue to carry this on the agenda until such time we hear back from PA DEP. Township Manager Renee Bickel said that as soon as we hear something, she will most certainly report back to the Board regarding this.
