#### **B. Fire Companies Report**

Chief Diaz submitted the response report via email for Cetronia for the month of September 2023. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Cetronia responded to sixty calls for the month of September 2023.

Chief Garger submitted the response report via email for Greenawalds for the month of September 2023. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Greenawalds responded to fifty-three calls for the month of September 2023. Chief Neas submitted the response reports via email for Tri-Clover for the month of September 2023 and year-to-date 2023. They are included as attachments to these minutes. Tri-Clover responded to twenty-six calls for the month of September 2023 and two-hundred and fifty-four calls year-to-date 2023.

Chief Search submitted the response report for Woodlawn for the month of September 2023. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Woodlawn responded to seventy calls for the month of September 2023.

Woodlawn will be holding an open house on October 7, 2023 from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm.

### D. Emergency Management Team Report

The township email notifications for weather statements are in the process of being set-up.

There will be a nationwide emergency alert test performed on October 4, 2023.

The emergency drill for the Limerick Generating Station was held on September 26, 2023. No deficiencies were identified.

There will be a cold-wash review on October 25, 2023 at 10:00 of the Parkland Active Aggressor Drill.

### E. Police Report

Sergeant Grozier submitted the Police report via email for the month of September 2023. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. The Police responded to one thousand, two-hundred and ninety-three calls, had one hundred and two reported crimes, and made forty-nine arrests for the month of September 2023. The incident numbers have increased this year over last and earlier years.

#### F. Emergency Medical Services Report

Chief Executive Officer Mateff reported that Cetronia responded to three-hundred and forty-two calls for the month of September 2023. Eleven of those calls were handled my mutual aid providers. Average response time is one minute, arrival time is nine minutes and eighteen seconds, time spent at the scene is sixteen minutes, and total time committed on a call is fifty-five minutes.

The members discussed the possibility of recommending that an additional hydrant should be installed on Huckleberry Road. It was noted that hydrants are proposed to be added on Huckleberry Road west of this subdivision as part of the Ridge Farm subdivision.


