

• Background Information:

The Township Engineer was previously engaged to provide an analysis and documentation to the Township for the restriction of truck traffic on Ridgeview Drive from Walbert Avenue to Huckleberry Road. Additionally, the Township Engineer was also authorized to conduct an analysis of the intersection of Ridgeview Drive and Walbert Avenue to determine the effects of allowing trucks on Ridgeview Drive from Bulldog Drive to Walbert Avenue.

Correspondence dated January 18, 2024 from the Township Engineer depicting the findings of said analysis for a restriction of truck traffic on Ridgeview Drive from Walbert Avenue to Huckleberry Road is enclosed for reference.

The Township Engineer has determined that it would be appropriate to restrict truck traffic on Ridgeview Drive from Walbert Avenue to Huckleberry Road. An Ordinance is required to implement this truck traffic restriction; a draft Ordinance is enclosed for reference, review and consideration of adoption. It is important to note that emergency traffic and local deliveries would not be restricted, per §336-31 of the Township Code of Ordinances.

Ridgeview Drive is a local road, so PennDOT does not determine whether or not the truck traffic should be restricted; it is a local decision. But Pidcock used PennDOT's standards as a guide to make this recommendation as it is the industry standard. The Township follows PennDOT's standards for road construction standards.

As part of this analysis, the Township Engineer also determined that it would not be appropriate to allow trucks on Ridgeview Drive from Bulldog Drive to Walbert Avenue due to the existing geometry and limited turning movements of the intersection/roadway.

Separately, the Township Engineer also conducted an analysis of the intersection of Church Road and Huckleberry Road to determine if additional and/or relocated signing would improve motorist awareness of the existing truck prohibition on Church Road. The results of said analysis as memorialized in the letter dated January 18, 2024 are also enclosed. An Ordinance is not required for this existing prohibition.

Signage is required in accordance with the Township Engineer's recommendations (provided in the enclosed letters dated January 18, 2024).

The Township Solicitor reviewed the draft ordinance prepared by the Township Manager and had no suggested revisions to the text.

The Board of Commissioners approved official action during the February 21st Board meeting to approve advertising the ordinance for adoption.

The public notice for the ordinance was published in the March 21st issue of the *Parkland Press*; the draft ordinance was also sent to the Lehigh County Department of Law on March 11, 2024. No comments were received on this ordinance following public advertisement.

RETENTION OF RIGHTS TO ENFORCE. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, by various ordinances and amendments thereto, the Board of Commissioners has previously adopted regulations governing traffic within the Township, which ordinances and amendments were consolidated into Chapter 336 upon the Township's adoption of its Codified Ordinance on December 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to amend a portion of Chapter 336, to include a truck traffic restriction on Ridgeview Drive as further described herein; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Publication 212, Official Traffic Control Devices specifically states in Section 212.117, Weight, size and load restrictions, that prohibitions or restrictions can be put in place based on the condition of a highway after an engineering evaluation. More specifically, Section 212.117(b) states the following:

Traffic on a highway may be prohibited or restricted by weight of vehicle, or kinds or classes of vehicles when warranted by an engineering evaluation... A restriction is warranted when... The highway pavement or shoulders have inadequate structural capacity or have been weakened due to deterioration, high traffic volumes or climatic condition, and may be seriously damaged unless a restriction is imposed.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a field inspection of Ridgeview Drive conducted by the Township Engineer on December 15, 2023, it was observed that the pavement surfaces along Ridgeview Drive showed deterioration in multiple areas which included previously patched potholes, cracks, cracking with spidering, pavement depressions, pavement rutting, and springs perking through pavement joints. These are indication that the pavement section is not adequate to support heavy loads and higher traffic volumes, both of which would lead to continued deterioration of the roadway surface; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has determined that the prohibition/restriction warrants as established by PennDOT in Publication 212, Section 212.117 are met for a truck traffic restriction on Ridgeview Drive between Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §336-31, nothing shall prohibit any person from driving an emergency vehicle on any of those streets or parts of streets, or from driving on any of those streets or parts of streets a truck or other commercial vehicle making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along that street or part of a street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of South Whitehall Township, as follows:

SECTION I – AMENDMENT TO PART II ("GENERAL LEGISLATION"), CHAPTER 336 ("VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"), ARTICLE III ("RESTRICTIONS ON SIZE, WEIGHT AND TYPE OF VEHICLE AND LOAD") OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF SOUTH WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP TO AMEND SECTION §336-31 ("TRUCK TRAFFIC RESTRICTED ON CERTAIN STREETS")

Part II ("General Legislation"), Chapter 336 ("Vehicles and Traffic"), Article III ("Restrictions on Size, Weight and Type of Vehicle and Load" of the Codified Ordinances of South Whitehall Township is hereby amended at §336-31 to revise (add) the following location:

Street	Between
Ridgeview Drive	Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road
	(approximate length of 3,470 feet)

SECTION II - REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III - FAILURE TO ENFORCE NOT A WAIVER

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV - SEVERABILITY

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION V - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately following its adoption by the Board of Commissioners.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH WHITEHALL, COUNTY OF LEHIGH, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING PART II ("GENERAL LEGISLATION"), CHAPTER 336 ("VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"), ARTICLE III ("RESTRICTIONS ON SIZE, WEIGHT AND TYPE OF VEHICLE AND LOAD") OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF SOUTH WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP TO AMEND SECTION §336-31 ("TRUCK TRAFFIC RESTRICTED ON CERTAIN STREETS") TO PROVIDE FOR A TRUCK TRAFFIC PROHIBITION ON RIDGEVIEW DRIVE BETWEEN WALBERT AVENUE AND HUCKLEBERRY ROAD; AND TO PROVIDE FOR A CLAUSE, RETENTION TO REPEALER OF **RIGHTS** ENFORCE. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, by various ordinances and amendments thereto, the Board of Commissioners has previously adopted regulations governing traffic within the Township, which ordinances and amendments were consolidated into Chapter 336 upon the Township's adoption of its Codified Ordinance on December 7, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to amend a portion of Chapter 336, to include a truck traffic restriction on Ridgeview Drive as further described herein; and

WHEREAS, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) Publication 212, Official Traffic Control Devices specifically states in Section 212.117, Weight, size and load restrictions, that prohibitions or restrictions can be put in place based on the condition of a highway after an engineering evaluation. More specifically, Section 212.117(b) states the following:

Traffic on a highway may be prohibited or restricted by weight of vehicle, or kinds or classes of vehicles when warranted by an engineering evaluation... A restriction is warranted when... The highway pavement or shoulders have inadequate structural capacity or have been weakened due to deterioration, high traffic volumes or climatic condition, and may be seriously damaged unless a restriction is imposed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a field inspection of Ridgeview Drive conducted by the Township Engineer on December 15, 2023, it was observed that the pavement surfaces along Ridgeview Drive showed deterioration in multiple areas which included previously patched potholes, cracks, cracking with spidering, pavement depressions, pavement rutting, and springs perking through pavement joints. These are indication that the pavement section is not adequate to support heavy loads and higher traffic volumes, both of which would lead to continued deterioration of the roadway surface; and

WHEREAS, the Township Engineer has determined that the prohibition/restriction warrants as established by PennDOT in Publication 212, Section 212.117 are met for a truck traffic restriction on Ridgeview Drive between Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to §336-31, nothing shall prohibit any person from driving an emergency vehicle on any of those streets or parts of streets, or from driving on any of those streets or parts of streets a truck or other commercial vehicle making local deliveries to or pickups from premises located along that street or part of a street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of South Whitehall Township, as follows:

<u>SECTION I</u> – AMENDMENT TO PART II ("GENERAL LEGISLATION"), CHAPTER 336 ("VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"), ARTICLE III ("RESTRICTIONS ON SIZE, WEIGHT AND TYPE OF VEHICLE AND LOAD") OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF SOUTH WHITEHALL TOWNSHIP TO AMEND SECTION §336-31 ("TRUCK TRAFFIC RESTRICTED ON CERTAIN STREETS")

Part II ("General Legislation"), Chapter 336 ("Vehicles and Traffic"), Article III ("Restrictions on Size, Weight and Type of Vehicle and Load" of the Codified Ordinances of South Whitehall Township is hereby amended at §336-31 to revise (add) the following location:

Street	Between
Ridgeview Drive	Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road
	(approximate length of 3,470 feet)

SECTION II - REPEALER

All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III - FAILURE TO ENFORCE NOT A WAIVER

The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this Ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.

SECTION IV - **SEVERABILITY**

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Commissioners that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION V - EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately following its adoption by the Board of Commissioners.

DULY ENACTED AND ORDAINED as an Ordinance this 3rd day of April, 2024 by a majority of the Board of Commissioners of South Whitehall Township, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania, at a duly advertised meeting of the Board of Commissioners at which a quorum was present. As part of this Ordinance, the Board of Commissioners has directed that the President, or Vice-President in the absence of the President, execute this Ordinance on behalf of the Board.

Dear Tom,

As requested, we have investigated the intersection of Church Road and Huckleberry Road to determine if additional and/or relocated signing would improve motorist awareness of the existing truck prohibition on Church Road. As seen in the attached sketch (our SK-1), there is currently 1 No Truck (R5-2) and Except Local Deliveries (R5-2-3) sign assembly along Church Road, approximately 80 feet south of the Huckleberry Road intersection. To improve visibility to motorists on Huckleberry Road, we recommend the following:

- Relocate the existing No Truck/Except Local Deliveries sign assembly to be 50 feet from Huckleberry Road, approximately 30 feet closer than currently;
- Add a second No Truck (R5-2 24"x24")/Except Local Deliveries (R5-2-3 24"x18") on the east side of Church Road opposite the relocated assembly;
- Add a Truck (M4-4 24"x12")/No Right Turn (R3-1 24"x24") assembly on the southwest corner of the intersection facing eastbound traffic, just west of the existing street name sign, with a Truck (M4-4 24"x12")/No Left Turn (R3-2 24"x24") assembly facing westbound traffic, and
- Add a Truck (M4-4 24"x12")/No Left Turn (R3-2 24"x24") assembly facing westbound traffic on the north side of the intersection near the Tall Timbers sign.

Dear Tom,

As requested, we have investigated the need to restrict trucks on Ridgeview Drive between Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road in accordance with PennDOT's guidelines identified in their Publication 212, Official Traffic Control Devices. The following discusses background information, the roadway conditions observed during our field observation, the requirements for restricting trucks, and conclusions of our investigation.

Ridgeview Drive serves a few residential properties between Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road, along with providing access to the farm on the west side of the road. The road has a railroad crossing near the Huckleberry Road connection which results in significant grade breaks due to the impact on the roadway profile. The speed limit is not currently posted along Ridgeview Drive. Based on PennDOT's Federal Functional Classification Map, Ridgeview Drive is within the urban area. As a result, the maximum speed limit for this section of roadway is 35 MPH according to Subchapter F, Section 3362(a) as identified in PennDOT's Title 75 (PA Vehicle Code).

During our field visit on December 15, 2023, the pavement surfaces along Ridgeview Drive showed deterioration in multiple areas which included previously patched potholes, cracks, cracking with spidering, pavement depressions, pavement rutting, and springs perking through pavement joints. These are typically signs that the pavement section is not adequate to support heavy loads and higher traffic volumes, both of which would lead to continued deterioration of the roadways.

PennDOT's Publication 212, Official Traffic Control Devices specifically states in Section 212.117, *Weight, size and load restrictions*, that prohibitions or restrictions can be put in place based on the condition of a highway after an engineering evaluation. More specifically, Section 212.117(b) states "Traffic on a highway may be prohibited or restricted by weight of vehicle, or kinds or classes of vehicles when warranted by an engineering evaluation... A restriction is warranted when... The highway pavement or shoulders have inadequate structural capacity or have been weakened due to deterioration, high traffic volumes or climatic condition, and may be seriously damaged unless a restriction is imposed."

Based on the deteriorating pavement conditions observed along Ridgeview Drive and PennDOT's guidelines on posting truck restrictions, it would appear that the prohibition/restriction warrants are met for Ridgeview Drive, between Walbert Avenue and Huckleberry Road, approximately 3,470 feet. Posting of No Truck (R5-2) signs with a supplemental Except Local Deliveries (R5-2-3) on either end of the restrictions along Ridgeview Drive are therefore appropriate. In addition, Truck (M4-4) / No Left Turn (R3-2) and Truck (M4-4) / No Right Turn (R3-1) sign assemblies are recommended facing Huckleberry Road motorists and Truck (M4-4) / No Turns (R3-3) sign assemblies are recommended facing Walbert Avenue motorists due to the existing truck restriction on Ridgeview Drive south of Walbert Avenue. For consistency, we recommend the existing No Truck sign south of the intersection be replaced with the No Truck (R5-2)/Except Local Deliveries (R5-2-3) sign assembly and be posted on both sides of Ridgeview Drive. The enclosed Sketch (our SK-1) depicts the proposed signing to alert motorists of the truck restriction.

Based on our understanding, an ordinance is required to be passed by the Board of Commissioners to enact the truck restriction. We recommend coordinating with the Township Solicitor regarding the legal requirements to enact this traffic restriction.





Background Information and/or Justification of Expense:

South Whitehall Township Administration along with the Public Works Department would like to move forward with applying for the 902 Grant. This grant can be applied for every two years. We applied in 2022 and were awarded \$316,575.00 and in 2024 we would like to apply for \$190,830.00 to purchase an Olympian Leaf Pro Vacuum trailer. The grant would cover 90% of \$171,747.00 and the Township match portion is 10% for \$19,083.00. Currently we use a trackless unit with a leaf head attachment which requires a minimum of four employees and with this new leaf vacuum trailer it will only require two employees. This will also lower our maintenance costs due to not having to rebuild the leaf heads every year.

The cost of maintenance for the leaf heads:

- 1. 2018 \$2,089.15
- 2. 2019 \$21,039.62
- 3. 2020 \$15,666.40
- 4. 2021 \$7,000
- 5. 2022 \$9,042.17
- 6. 2023 \$10,286.91

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) announces the opening of a new section 902 grant round to support the development of municipal recycling programs under section 902 of the Municipal Waste Planning, Recycling and Waste Reduction Act of 1988 (Act 101) (53 P.S. § 4000.902). Municipalities eligible for recycling grants include counties, cities, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships, home rule municipalities, councils of governments, consortiums or similar entities established by two or more municipalities under 53

Pa.C.S. Chapter 23, Subchapter A (relating to intergovernmental cooperation). The application deadline is May 10, 2024, at 11:59 p.m.

Application Requirements

Municipalities who received a 902 only grant award in 2023 are not eligible to apply for funding during this solicitation period, unless they are a newly mandated municipality based on the 2020 decennial census. Municipalities compliant with Act 101 are eligible and may apply. Applicants must be in compliance with the provisions of Act 101 and the implementing regulations, the Department's Guidelines for Proper Management of Recyclable Materials and any previous grant contract provisions to be eligible to receive grant funding. County applicants should be in compliance with planning and other county-related provisions of Act 101. Applicants who are not in compliance with Act 101 and annual reporting requirements or the program performance recycling grant requirements of the act of November 9, 2006 (P.L. 1347, No. 140) will not be considered. Programs must operate in compliance with their municipality's land use plan where applicable.

Municipalities are eligible for 90% funding of approved recycling program costs. Municipalities considered financially distressed by the Department of Community and Economic Development under the Municipalities Financial Recovery Act (53 P.S. §§ 11701.101—11701.712) are eligible for 100% of approved costs. An application requesting more than \$200,000 in grant funding will not be accepted.

Applicants are required to complete the Sustainability Plan portion of the application that includes definitive actions and strategies for optimizing program self-sufficiency. The plan shall include, at a minimum, strategies for reducing costs and generating revenues, provisions for establishing incentives associated with waste reduction and recycling, mechanisms for public outreach and stakeholder input and tracking mechanisms to document progress toward sustainability milestones until optimum sustainability is realized. The Department's technical report on Building Financially Sustainable Recycling Programs can provide assistance in developing the methods and strategies. The technical report can be found on the Department's web site at http://files.dep.state.pa.us/Waste/Recycling/RecyclingPortalFiles/Documents/fin_sust_rec.pdf. Applicants that fail to complete the Sustainability Plan portion of the application will not be considered for funding.

The following elements will receive priority for funding:

- Newly mandated municipalities based on the 2020 decennial census by the Bureau of the Census of the United States Department of Commerce.
- Development and implementation of incentive-based pricing and collection programs designed to increase the quantities and types of recyclable materials and reduce the quantity of waste collected.
 - Development and implementation of a food waste collection or management program, or both.
- Development and implementation of multimunicipal collection, processing or a materials marketing program, or both, where capital costs are reduced or recycling marketability is enhanced, or both, due to intergovernmental cooperation.
- Municipal recycling programs that will develop and implement methods of collection and processing of recyclable materials through source-separation, dual-stream or commingled practices. The applicant must demonstrate that these recyclable materials have value and greater marketability.
 - New and innovative recycling educational programs that support the applicants' recycling collection efforts.

In addition, communities whose existing recycling programs contain the following components will receive additional consideration:

• Publicly provided or municipally contracted waste and recycling services.

- The collection of six or more of the following materials: newsprint, office paper, corrugated paper, other marketable grades of paper, aluminum cans, steel or bimetallic cans, colored glass containers, clear glass containers and plastics.
- Municipal recycling programs that are currently collecting and processing recyclable materials through source-separation, dual-stream or commingled practices. The applicant must demonstrate that these recyclable materials have value and greater marketability.
- Incentive-based pricing and collection programs designed to increase the quantities and types of recyclable materials and reduce the quantity of waste collected.

Special consideration will be given to those applicants identified in Environmental Justice (EJ) Areas:

- The Department defines an EJ Area as a geographic area characterized by increased pollution burden and sensitive or vulnerable populations based on demographic and environmental data.
- The Department has provided the PennEnviroScreen tool which can be accessed at https://www.dep.pa.gov/PublicParticipation/OfficeofEnvironmentalJustice/Pages/PA-Environmental-Justice-Areas.aspx to help assist communities in making this assessment and, for the purposes of the Department's EJ policy, identifies EJ areas as areas with a score above 80, indicating within the top 80th percentile of communities based on pollution burden and sensitive or vulnerable populations.

Eligibility Requirements

Only those projects involving municipalities that have a mandatory trash collection program or projects seeking support for a residential recycling program that have a corresponding commercial recycling program will be considered for funding. Applicants seeking funds to replace curbside collection containers or collection vehicles, or both, will need to demonstrate that the new equipment will increase collection efficiencies and tonnage of materials.

Eligibility Costs

Eligible recycling program development costs include: recycling program design costs, recycling market investigations, development of recycling market commitments, development of recycling program ordinances; development of recycling public education programs, and the costs of developing contracts for procuring equipment or services necessary for the operation of the recycling program.

Eligible recycling program implementation costs include: purchasing or leasing vehicles used to collect recyclables, transporting recyclables to processing facilities or markets and vehicles used in the operation of a materials recovery facility; reusable containers for the collection or storage of recyclable materials; acquiring or renovating buildings, or both, for the processing or storage of recovered materials; equipment used to process or manufacture recyclable materials into usable products; improvements to land needed to operate a recycling facility, food waste composting facility or leaf/yard waste composting facility authorized under 25 Pa. Code § 271.103(h) (relating to permit-by-rule for municipal waste processing facilities other than for regulated medical or chemotherapeutic waste; qualifying facilities; general requirements) and the costs associated with educating the public on recycling program requirements.

Under this grant solicitation, the following will not be eligible for funding: promotional items glass crushing equipment (unless specific marketing arrangements have been identified), vehicles equipped with compaction units (except for the sole collection of yard waste or paper fiber), and backyard composting units and public recycling containers for parks and streetscapes.

Other eligible and noneligible costs are listed in the grant application packet. Food waste or leaf/yard waste, or both, collection/composting projects and programs will be considered to be recycling projects or programs accordingly.

A municipality must retain sole ownership of equipment or facilities funded by the grant. Funding for equipment or facilities purchased for the recycling program used for recycling and other purposes will be prorated according to its recycling use. (No equipment used for recycling less than 50% of the time will be eligible for funding.) Funding for certain leaf and yard waste collection equipment may be limited according to its seasonal use. Funding for wood chipping equipment will be approved only when the equipment is part of an approved yard waste composting facility operating under the Department's guidelines and where the material is collected curbside from residents. Funding of street sweepers for the purpose of leaf collection will not be considered.

Funding may be restricted in situations where equipment or services requested through a grant application may be available from the public or private sector within the county of the applicant. Public notices may be required before the grant application may be submitted depending upon the nature of the funding request. When the municipality submits the recycling grant application to the Department, it must include proof of compliance with the notification requirements, a description of any responses received to the notice and an explanation of why the municipality has concluded that the mechanical processing equipment is not available to the program from the private sector.

Requirement for Preapplication Conference

Potential applicants must contact the appropriate Department regional planning and recycling coordinator to schedule a preapplication conference to discuss application requirements and program particulars. A list of these individuals is included in this notice. Applications will be returned to municipalities that fail to schedule a preapplication conference. Grant application preapplication forms are available from the Department's web site at www.dep.pa.gov (search term "902 Recycling Grants Financial Assistance").

Application Deadline

Grant applications must be submitted through the Department of Community and Economic Development's Electronic Single Application web site, eGrants, at www.esa.dced.state.pa.us. Applications must be received by May 10, 2024, at 11:59 p.m., to be eligible for funding. Applications will not be accepted after the deadline. Grant awards are predicated on the receipt of recycling fees required by sections 701 and 702 of Act 101 (53 P.S. §§ 4000.701 and 4000.702) and the availability of moneys in the Recycling Fund.

• Background Information and/or Justification of Expense:

Public Works is respectfully asking for a motion to proceed with ordering a Bandit Intimidator 15XP (Drum Style). Public Works solicited 3 quotes (Stephenson Equipment, Bobcat and Vermeer) and 1 being a costars quote. The current chipper is a 2001 Bandit disk chipper. We cannot tell how many hours are on this machine as the counter does not work. Attached are the maintenance records from 2001 forward. We cannot supply the older records as that was in the old AS-400 system. This piece of equipment will stay in the fleet and be used for emergencies only like when we have bad rain or snowstorm. Last year we ended up renting 3 chippers after we had a rainstorm with high winds to be able to clean all the down trees and branches throughout the township. The price of this new Bandit Chipper is \$96,942.50.





• Background Information:

South Whitehall Township management/administration have observed repeated instances of flooding and scouring at Covered Bridge Park along the Jordan Creek.

Upon review of the 2013/2014 Covered Bridge Park Master Site Plan, the proposed current and future amenities were built around the concept of remediating the environmental and flooding concerns related to the Jordan Creek. As the park has been developed over time, the environmental and hydrogeological issues have not been rectified and the flooding/scouring issues have continued.

Township management/administration have determined it is in the best interests of the Township to evaluate potential options for the long-term environmental remediation of the Jordan Creekboth upstream and downstream of the Covered Bridge Park/Wehr's Dam area with the broadly defined goal of improving the stream morphology.

Enclosed is a professional services proposal for environmental services firm, LandStudies, to conduct a Feasibility Assessment and Concept Plan Development for the Jordan Creek at Covered Bridge Park in the amount of \$9,900.00. LandStudies is an environmental firm based in Lititz, PA that has extensive background and experience in working with municipalities on environmental issues and ecological plans. Their staff has the appropriate certifications and experience to assist the Township with this project.

The overall proposed intent of this study and the key factors associated with this study are identified as follows:

- Identify options for environmental remediation options in the identified study area based on the existing layout and configuration of Covered Bridge Park.
- It is important to note that this study is a starting point to help give the Township options to consider for future study and remediation options. This proposal is not for a complete

Hydrologic and Hydraulic (H&H) Study. However, the scope of work of this proposal will confirm whether it would be recommended to conduct a full H&H Study as an option.

• This study is not necessarily a panacea for all of the above-identified issues at Covered Bridge Park. This is a starting point in order for the Township, including management/administration and the governing body, to evaluate future potential remediation options.

• Action Requested:

No specific action is requested at this time. This agenda item has been listed under Direction/Discussion in order to receive feedback and comment from the Board of Commissioners as to whether or not the governing body is inclined to proceed with this project as defined in the proposal.

Thank you for the opportunity to prepare a scope of work to evaluate 7,300 LF of Jordan Creek at Covered Bridge Park, within the extents shown on the attached assessment map, and prepare a concept plan and narrative summary for restoration opportunities that have multiple benefits to the township and community. LandStudies completed an assessment and master plan working with YSM Landscape Architects for the township in 2013/14 and is familiar with the site conditions at the time. We will use this background knowledge to build a concept plan aligned with the new goals of the township. We understand that the intent is to evaluate options with the dam remaining in place, and that assessment and recommendations are needed both upstream and downstream of the dam. This concept plan and summary narrative will be a guide for the township to take the next steps toward design, permit, and ultimately construction. The deliverables will also serve in support of future grant applications for project funding.

The following scope of work outlines the services we propose:

SCOPE OF WORK

Task 1 – Concept Plan

LandStudies will review the available site data provided by South Whitehall Township, as well as additional site mapping and watershed information that is available online. We will review previously prepared plans and work developed for the project vicinity that are available and relevant to proposed concept goals. A water resources engineer, and landscape architect will meet with stakeholders and conduct a site visit to evaluate the condition and dimensions of the existing channel, the presence of Legacy Sediment on the site, and other potential site constraints and opportunities. Based on the background information and the site assessment findings, we will develop a conceptual restoration plan as a planning tool for the township. We will

Professional Services

Fixed Fee Projects: Unless otherwise agreed, payment schedule is based on the percent of work completed for each phase of work.

Time and Material (T&M) Projects: Billings are based on the hours worked, including travel time, and actual expenses incurred plus profit. Where an estimated total has been given, unless specifically noted, it is not a guaranteed figure but is provided solely to assist in project planning.

Overtime: Overtime service will be provided only upon authorization at 1.5 times the hourly rate.

Equipment Usage – Costs for use of company equipment on a project site will be billed at a set rate, rates are available upon request. Direct expenses will be charged at cost plus profit.

Proposals

Proposals are open for thirty (30) days, unless withdrawn within that time. If work begins upon Client's request prior to execution of an agreement or engagement letter, these terms will govern the terms of the engagement. When an agreement or engagement letter is executed, these terms will supplement the agreement. If there is a conflict between these terms and conditions and the terms of any such agreement or engagement letter, the terms of this agreement or engagement letter will prevail. These terms and conditions will apply to the agreement between LandStudies and the Client, unless otherwise expressly agreed, notwithstanding contrary terms or conditions contained in any purchase order, engagement letter, agreement, or other document which Client uses to accept Landstudies' proposal.

Client's Responsibility

In addition to other agreed upon obligations, the Client must assure access to the site and suitable storage areas for LandStudies' tools, equipment, and materials. Client must timely provide complete physical information about the site and/or buildings, including but not limited to surveys, maps, elevations, flow rates, hazardous substances, and the like, necessary or desirable for LandStudies to complete its work. Client must also timely provide access to legal, accounting, and insurance advice as LandStudies may require, and Client must timely review proposals, schedules, plans, and specifications prepared by LandStudies, and cooperate with LandStudies so that LandStudies may complete its work in a timely fashion. Client further agrees to credit LandStudies, Inc. in any publicity referencing the project design. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, Client shall obtain at its expense all permits and authorizations necessary for performance of LandStudies' work or for the project of which LandStudies' work is a part.

Invoices

Unless otherwise agreed, Clients will generally be invoiced monthly for services performed during the previous month. Payment is due on receipt. Interest will be added after 30 days at the rate of 1.5% per month or partial month overdue. LandStudies, Inc. may suspend or terminate its work upon ten days notice if any invoice is not paid when due. Client will reimburse LandStudies its reasonable attorney's fees and litigation costs incurred in pursuing collection of any amount due from Client.

Reimbursable Expenses

In addition to payment of fees, Client must reimburse LandStudies for its out-of-pocket expenses incurred in performing the work, such as, but not limited to, prints, reproducible, photocopies, travel related expenses, mileage, deliveries, long distance communications, fax transmissions, photography, outside consultants, approval and permit fees, and any supplemental insurance requested. Reimbursable expenses will be billed at LandStudies' standard rates plus 10 percent. If LandStudies engages any subcontractor to perform work for Client, or a portion of LandStudies' work, then Client shall reimburse LandStudies the subcontract cost, plus 15%. Reimbursement will be provided at cost for any sales tax which may be assessed in the course of providing professional services.

Change of Work, Delays

In fixed fee engagements, changes to the work are not covered and will be billed at LandStudies' hourly rates or in accordance with a change order. When practicable, additional work or changes to the work shall be made by written change orders submitted to and approved by Client. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Client will be bound by any changes to the work authorized by it. Among other circumstances, changes to the work should be anticipated in projects constructed by methods where design and coordination services may be out of typical sequence or scheduling. If LandStudies is delayed in commencing or completing its work due to causes beyond its control, including but not limited to Client's failure to perform any of its obligations in a timely fashion, LandStudies reserves the right to increase its fees for the work in an equitable amount as compensation for the delay.

Additional Services

Services beyond those agreed to, including among others, revisions due to adjustments in the project scope, quality, or budget are considered Additional Services and will be billed at the hourly rates referenced above.

Dispute Resolution

All claims and disputes relating to the services provided shall be resolved by arbitration under the rules of the American Arbitration Association in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. In any litigation, arbitration, or other proceeding by which one party either seeks to enforce its rights under this Agreement or seeks a declaration of any rights or obligations under this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be awarded its reasonable attorney fees, and costs and expenses incurred. The decision of the arbitrators shall be final and binding and judgment may be entered upon any such decision in any court of competent jurisdiction. The agreement between LandStudies is considered to have been made in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and any action or arbitration may be commenced and maintained in and only in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. The agreement between LandStudies and Client shall be governed by and construed under Pennsylvania law.

Limitation of Liability, Indemnification

Unless expressly agreed to the contrary, damages incurred by Client, or with respect to which Client is threatened as a result of any action or failure to act arising out of LandStudies' work (whether as a breach of contract or the negligent or claimed negligence of LandStudies) shall in no event exceed the greater of \$50,000 or the total amount of LandStudies' fees paid by Client in connection with the work. Client shall indemnify, defend, and hold LandStudies harmless from and against any and all cost, damage, losses, liability and actions to which it may be subject, or with which it may be threatened as a result of anything Client or its representatives, contractors, subcontractors, employees or agents do, or fail to do, in connection with the project of which the work is a part, or as a result of any failure by Client to perform any of its obligations under this agreement.

Use of LandStudies Drawings and Photographs

The drawings and specifications provided by LandStudies belong to LandStudies. Client's rights are limited to a nontransferable license of use solely with respect to the project of which LandStudies' work is a part. LandStudies retains all rights, including but not limited to copyrights therein. Copies may be retained by the Client for reference, but may not be used on any other projects or to complete this project without consent of LandStudies. Owner grants to LandStudies and LandStudies reserves the right to utilize documents produced by LandStudies under this agreement along with photographs, prints, and/or digital images of the project before, during and after construction for their promotional use.

Termination of Agreement

In addition to LandStudies' other rights of termination, either party may terminate this agreement upon 30 days prior written notice if the other fails to perform any of its obligations in a timely manner and such failure is not cured within such thirty-day period. If commencement or performance of LandStudies work is delayed or suspended (not a result of LandStudies failure to perform its obligations) for more than sixty days, LandStudies, Inc. may either terminate this agreement upon ten days prior written notice to Client or receive delay charges from Client sufficient in LandStudies' reasonable determination to compensate it for such delay. In the event of termination of this agreement for any reason, Client shall pay LandStudies all its fees and reimbursable expenses for work performed through the date of termination, however, if termination is for any reason other than LandStudies' failure to perform its work, then Client shall pay LandStudies the greater of (a) all such fees and reimbursable expenses, plus twenty percent, or (b) ninety percent of any fixed fee agreement plus all reimbursable expenses, or (c) ninety percent of the estimated fees to be charged by LandStudies for performance of the work. If this agreement is terminated by for any reason other than because of LandStudies' failure to perform its work, it shall have no obligation whatsoever with respect to the work performed or anticipated to be performed hereunder.

Insurance

LandStudies, Inc. maintains Workman's Compensation Insurance, General Liability Insurance, Automobile Insurance, and Professional Liability Insurance. Copies of insurance certificates are available upon request.

Estimates

Any estimate of costs and expenses relating to the project of which the work is a part or of LandStudies work itself, other than in fixed fee arrangements, are estimates only. LandStudies cannot assure that actual construction or other costs will not vary from any proposal or project budget. Client should anticipate that some changes and adjustments in the project will be required either during or after construction.
