The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

AGENDA ITEM #2 - APPROVAL OF MINUTES

AGENDA ITEM #3 - OLD BUSINESS

The township has received positive resident feedback regarding the speed humps that have been installed on Trexler Boulevard. The residents on Highland Street are desiring to have the speed humps installed on Highland Street. An additional speed hump will be installed on Trexler Boulevard and two temporary speed humps will be installed on Highland Street when weather conditions are dry enough to permit their installation. Traffic counts will be conducted after the installation of the speed humps.

AGENDA ITEM #5 - NEW BUSINESS

A. Commissioner's Report

Commissioner Peischl indicated that a public survey related to the Township Transportation PLAN has been posted on the township website. The first public meeting in the plan development process was held on March 28, 2024.

B. Fire Companies Report

Chief Diaz submitted the response report via email for Cetronia for the month of March 2024. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Cetronia responded to fifty-two calls for the month of March 2024. Seventy-five percent of those calls were in their primary coverage area.

Cetronia will be celebrating their 100-year anniversary on June 29, 2024 from 12:00 noon to 7:00 pm.

Chief Garger submitted the response report via email for Greenawalds for the month of March 2024. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Greenawalds responded to forty-five calls for the month of March 2024 Greenawalds held their annual Community Easter Egg Hunt on Saturday March 30, 2024.

Several of their firefighters are going through the Firefighter 1 and Hazardous Materials Professional Certification process.

Chief Neas submitted the response reports via email for Tri-Clover for the month of March 2024 and year-to-date 2024. They are included as an attachment to these minutes. Tri-Clover responded to twenty-three calls for the month of March 2024 and ninety-six calls year-to-date 2024.

Several of their firefighters are going through vehicle rescue training.

Chief Search submitted the response report for Woodlawn for the month of March 2024. It is included as an attachment to these minutes. Woodlawn responded to fifty-four calls for the month of March 2024.

C. Emergency Management Team Report

Coordinator Kelly submitted the Emergency Management report for the month of March 2024. It is included as an attachment to these minutes.

The meetings are progressing with the Township Traffic and Transportation plan. The consultant hired to assist with the plan development is effectively running the meetings.

An electric vehicle patient extrication demonstration will be held at the Lehigh Valley EMA Conference. Members of the Commission may attend this demonstration.

Meeting with the Northeast Healthcare Coalition are continuing, with a focus on home health care organizations.

D. Police Report

Interim Chief Brown reported that the Police responded to one thousand, one hundred and twenty-one calls, had eighty-nine reported crimes, issued one hundred and forty-nine citations, two-hundred and seventeen warnings, and made twenty-seven arrests for the month of March 2024.

E. Emergency Medical Services Report

Chief Executive Officer Mateff reported via email that Cetronia responded to three-hundred and six calls for the month of March 2024. Five of those

calls were handled by mutual aid providers. The average time from dispatch to on-scene was seven minutes and fifty-two seconds with Friday being the busiest day of the week and 10:00 am being the busiest time of the day.

H. Address Assignments

Commissioner Peischl reported that there is a residential property at 1515 North 29th Street that was a confusing access. Although being addressed to North 29th Street, the access to the property is from the 1500 block of North Main Street. He inquired if the Commission would make the recommendation that township staff contact Lehigh County Communications Center to see if they can add a note in their CAD system to indicate that the property is accessed from North Main Street.

The Commission agreed with Commissioner Peischl and made the recommendation that township staff contact Lehigh County Communication Center to have them add a note to their CAD system to indicate that access to the property at 1515 North 29th Street is from the 1500 block of North Main Street.






