** IMPORTANT - Residents must complete a Yard Waste Drop Off Form at the Township Building or online at www.southwhitehall.com. Once the Township approves your request, you will receive a confirmation email. Your vehicle sticker then will be mailed to your residence within 3 to 5 days.

* The sticker must be placed on the inside of front windshield, near the top on the drivers side*

Recycling Containers are Available for the Following Items:

Magazines And "Junk Mail", Mixed Office Paper, Corrugated Cardboard (Please flatten), Cardboard – tissue boxes, cereal boxes, gift boxes, paper bags and wrapping, Glass and Cans, All plastic containers labeled #1 through #7, Metal – Aluminum foil and foil plates, metal lids, beer and soda cans.

Acceptable Yard Waste Material

Tree trimmings – up to 8" in diameter and 4' in length, Shrubbery and hedge trimmings and pruning, Garden waste (tomato plants, weeds)

Unacceptable Yard Waste Material

Grass clippings / Sod, Ornamental grass, Pumpkins, Cornstalks, Hay/ straw bails, Whole trees larger than 8" X 4', Tree roots, Rocks, Dirt, Stones, Bricks, Household trash, lumber, fence posts, pine cones and leaves.

We do have a dumpster to dispose of grass clippings and Ornamental Grass

Other Rules and Guidelines

- No Contractors
- Residents are limited to a maximum load equivalent to a pickup truck 8' bed, or a trailer; 6' x 8' trailer pulled by a car or car/SUV per day.
