This is for the little ones, ages 3 to 6 months. Puppies must have vaccinations appropriate for their age. Class content includes: confidence building, leash manners, introduction to basic commands and answers to basic puppy questions. This class introduces the basic skills of paying attention, the sit, down, stay and come commands, and walking on a leash. Emphasis is placed on proper management of problem behaviors like mouthing, house training and socialization.

Prerequisite: Dogs must be at least 5 months

We help you to understand your dog and resolve problem behaviors. Class content includes: focus (dog's attention focused on you), sit, down, greeting people with a well-mannered dog, will learn how to stay in place, how to come when called, and how to walk nicely on leash. Time is spent discussing different tools, such as collars and leashes, which can be useful in training, as well as brief discussions on adolescent behaviors and challenges. Basic Manners also includes a Leave It command, and different ways to prevent a dog from jumping up on you or other people, and an introduction to heeling on leash. The class emphasis is on applying what is learned to real life so that you have a well-behaved pet that you can enjoy.
